

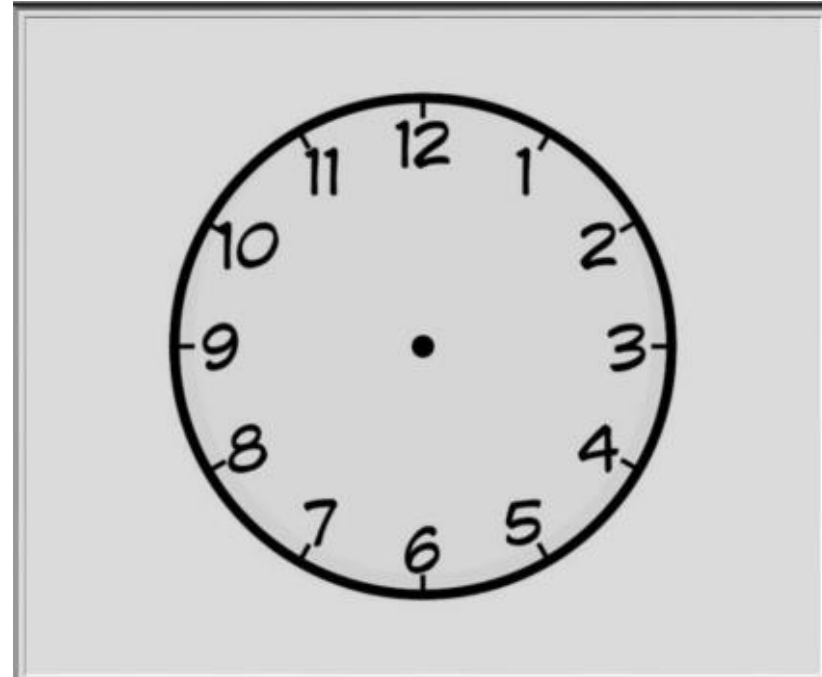

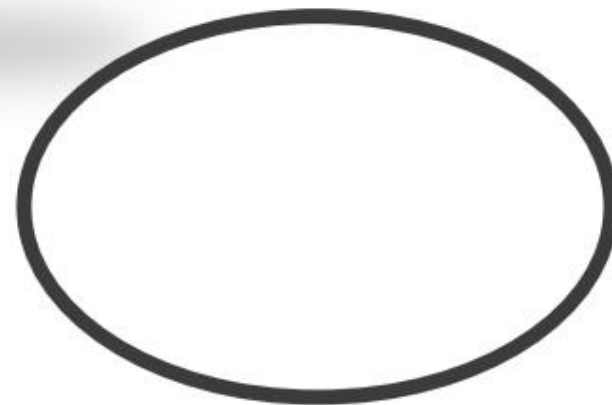

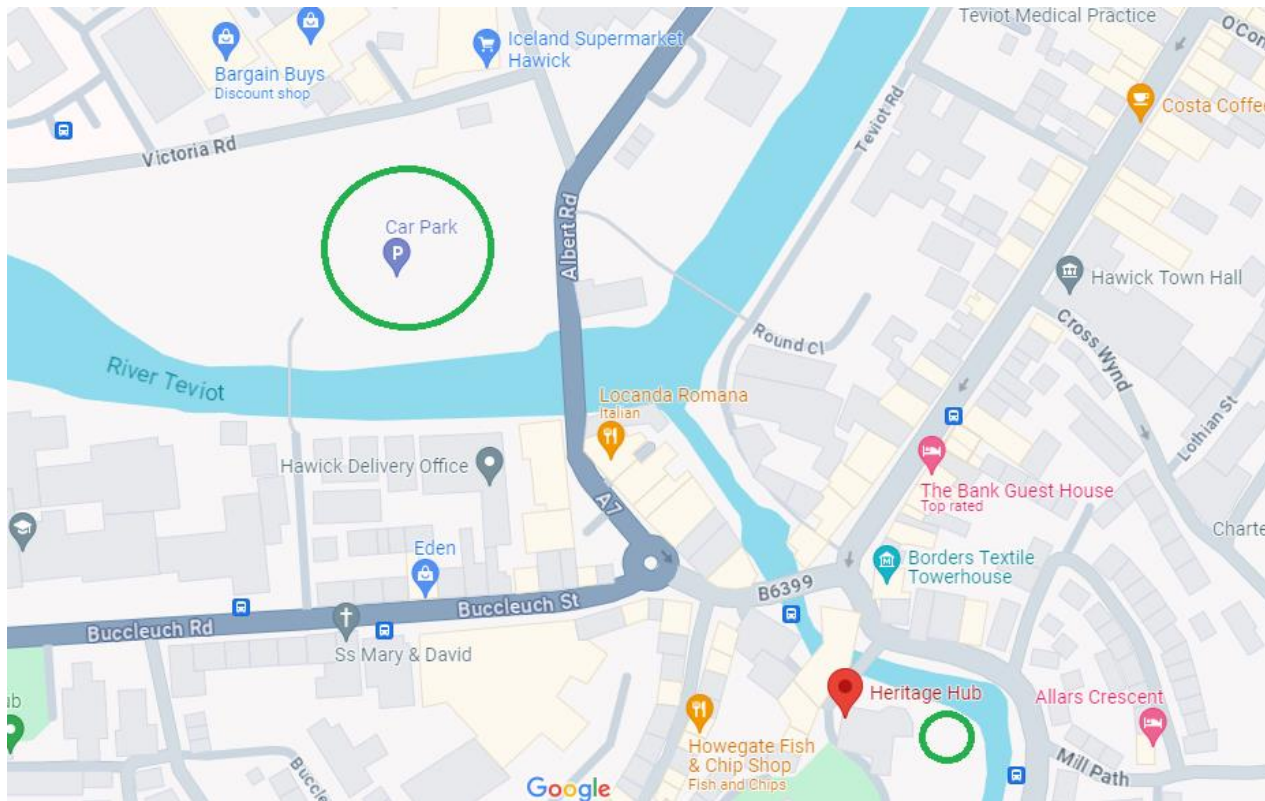

There are accessible toilets in the foyer area. If you're not sure where to find the toilets, please just ask a member of staff.

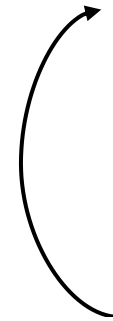
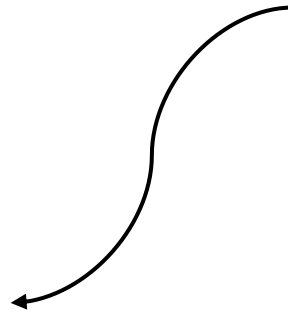


The toilets have automatic lighting.
