




What to know before your visit

What time will you have to start travelling to make it here on time?




How are you getting here?

There are accessible toilets in the foyer area. If you're not sure where to find the toilets, please just ask a member of staff.




The toilets have automatic lighting.

They also have emergency alarms should you require assistance.


When you're ready to leave
